Connecting skills for green blue network restoration

People enjoying a Wetlanders pilot site show that life around green blue networks (GBNs) is already thriving, with room for even stronger connections.

These landscapes are more than habitats; they are shared spaces where people and nature meet. Yet across North-West Europe, many are under pressure from drainage, fragmentation and declining biodiversity. And as they weaken, so do the connections that tie communities to them.

Wetlanders works closely with local communities, authorities, land managers, SMEs and citizen groups to restore GBN habitats and strengthen those that depend on them.
