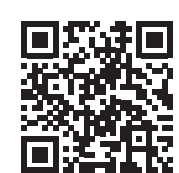
Leveraging seawater energy for a sustainable community future

The island of Vlieland faces rising energy needs, especially during busy tourist seasons. Through the AquaCOM project, the harbour of Vlieland is trying something bold: extracting heat from seawater.

By combining aquathermal energy with solar-powered heat pumps, they are creating a clean, local heating network – a circular solution in line with Vlieland's 2050 gas-free goal that could inspire the entire Wadden Sea region.
